Elderly adults (65 years of age and older) have weaker immune responses, there are many reasons why people in that age group should be vaccinated each year.

- People aged 65+ are at an increased risk of serious illness, hospitalizations, and death from the flu.
- Vaccination has been shown in several studies to reduce the severity of illness.
- In frail elderly adults, hospitalizations can mark the beginning of a significant decline in overall health and mobility.

Please keep in mind, getting vaccinated yourself may also protect the elderly population around you.

Remember to refrain from visiting if you are experiencing fever, cough, or sore throat. Always wash hands before and after you visit, cover your cough, and use a tissue.

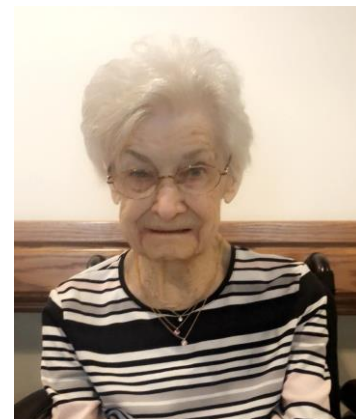
